

# Third Party (Vendor) Privacy Notice

**Last Updated Date: May 18, 2026**

Alkem Laboratories Ltd (“**Company**”, “**Alkem**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, “**our**”) is committed to protecting the privacy and security of Personal Data in accordance with applicable data protection laws, including the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 (“**DPDPA**”). This Third Party (Vendors) Privacy Notice (“**Notice**”) applies to individuals associated with Alkem’s thirdparty vendors, suppliers, consultants, contractors, service providers, and other business partners (collectively, “**Vendors**” or “**Data Principals**”) who provide goods or services to, or otherwise engage in business with, Alkem. This Notice describes how Alkem collects, receives, stores, uses, discloses, shares, and otherwise processes Personal Data of such Third Party (Vendors) (“**Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data**”) in connection with its business operations.

## 1. Types of Personal Data Collected

Alkem may collect, hold, use, and process the following categories of Third Party (Vendors) Data, including but not limited to:

- i. **General Personal Data:** Name, designation, signature, business contact details (address, phone number, email ID), communication records etc
  
- i. **Government Identifiers:** PAN, Aadhaar (where permitted), GST No., TAN, licenses, registrations, and other statutory identifiers
- ii. **Financial Data:** Bank account details, payment details, invoicing information

*(Note: Personal Data collected is limited to what is necessary for vendor onboarding, engagement, and compliance purposes.)*

## 1. Purpose of Collection

Alkem collects, holds, uses, and otherwise processes the Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data for the purposes described below, or for purposes which are reasonably compatible with the ones described below:

- Processing for consent as a lawful basis such as:
  - To onboard, manage, and maintain vendor relationships
  - To perform due diligence, background checks, and vendor evaluations prior to onboarding
  - To execute and manage contracts and business engagements
  - To process payments, invoices, and financial transactions
  - To maintain vendor master records and internal systems
  - To communicate with vendor representatives
  
- Processing for legitimate uses where processing is necessary such as:
  - To conduct various internal and external audits
  - To comply with applicable legal, regulatory, and tax obligations
  - Establishment and defense of legal claims

## 1. Disclosure and Sharing of Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data

As a part of its normal business operations, Alkem may disclose the Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data in the manner detailed below. Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data is shared with only those parties that provide an adequate level of data protection by implementing appropriate technical and organizational security measures as prescribed by applicable law. We do not sell Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data to anyone.

- **Internal stakeholders** on a need-to-know basis
- **Group entities and affiliates** for business and operational purposes
- **Service providers and vendors** (e.g., IT, logistics, payment processors), subject to appropriate safeguards
- **Regulatory authorities, government bodies, or law enforcement agencies**, where required by law
- **Third parties in connection with business restructuring**, including mergers, acquisitions, or transfers

#### 1. **Transfer of Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data Outside India**

Alkem operates globally and may transfer the Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data in territories outside India for the purposes described in this Notice and in accordance with applicable data protection laws in such territories. Such transfer of Third Party (Vendors) Data may be to its affiliated or group companies or to third parties, primarily for business and operational purposes.

##### 1. **Retention of Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data**

Alkem will retain Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data for as long as reasonably considered necessary for achieving the purposes detailed in this Notice and as is permissible under applicable law. Alkem may further retain Personal Data for longer periods where required for legal, regulatory, or contractual purposes, or for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims.

##### 1. **Security Practices and Procedures**

Alkem has adopted reasonable security safeguards in compliance with applicable laws to secure Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data. Alkem also ensures that the third parties to whom Third Party (Vendors) Personal Data is transferred or disclosed will have at least the same level of security practices as that followed by Alkem.

##### 1. **Your Rights in Connection with your Personal Data**

In relation to your Personal Data, you have the following rights:

- **Right to access:** Third Party (Vendors) can request access to their Personal Data held by Alkem.
- **Right to correction:** Third Party (Vendors) has the right to correct any inaccurate or incomplete Personal Data. The Third Party (Vendors) is responsible for informing Alkem if there are any changes or inaccuracies to their Personal Data.
- **Right to erasure:** Third Party (Vendors) have the right to request the erasure of their Personal Data in certain circumstances. If you believe that we should discontinue the use of your Personal Data, you have the option to request the deletion of your Personal Data. Alkem shall delete the Personal Data unless retention is necessary for compliance with any law for the time being in force.
- **Right of grievance redressal:** Any grievance related to the processing or handling of the Third Party (Vendors) Data shall be intimated to the Grievance Officer at [dataprivacy@alkem.com](mailto:dataprivacy@alkem.com).
- **Right to nominate:** Third Party (Vendors) have the right to nominate another individual to exercise their rights in case of death or incapacity
- **Right to withdraw consent:** Third Party (Vendors) have a right to withdraw their consent for the activities they had consented for, although the right will have limited applicability as only in cases where consent-based processing does apply. The withdrawal of consent previously granted for the processing of personal data does not affect the lawfulness of the processing until the withdrawal. However, opting out will result in cessation of the respective activity or services.

You may be asked to furnish proof of your identity before you can exercise these rights. Alkem may not be able to process any requests made in the event you fail to establish your identity, or if we are unable to authenticate your identity.

If you believe that we have not adequately addressed your request or concerns, you have the right to file a complaint with the Data Protection Board. However, you are encouraged to contact Alkem first, as we welcome the opportunity to investigate and resolve any concerns.

We are committed to cooperating with the Data Protection Board in the resolution of any complaints and ensuring that all concerns are addressed in a timely and appropriate manner.
